

FitzGerald Bros Circus

Movements through Australia and New Zealand in 1891-9

FitzGerald Bros Circus was Australia's largest circus in the 1890s and early 1900s. It was conducted by Dan and Tom FitzGerald. This was the first Australian circus to rely substantially on rail and shipping for transport, the first to tour Australasia according to standardised routes and the first to regularly import troupes of performers from Europe and America. Both brothers died in 1906, within months of each other. Although Mrs Tom FitzGerald carried on with the circus for a few years, what remained was eventually taken over by the FitzGeralds' longstanding rivals, Wirth Bros Circus.
